
## Coming to our Schools Just in Time for the Civil War Sesquicentennial Two Traveling Trunks on Civil War Medical Care


To be headquartered at the 6<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Museum, the educational traveling trunks will provide learning materials for both 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. Focusing on medical care during the Civil War, especially during and following the battle of Chickamauga, these materials will be available for teachers as a supplement to our traveling exhibit "The Blood Ran Blue and Gray."

## **Preliminary Materials List:**

- 1. At least five grade appropriate books relating to Civil War medical care,
- 2. A nurse's apron and bonnet and kepis (one each Union and Confederate) with appropriate medical insignia,
- 3. Other medical-related replicas suitable for classroom display, use, and discussion,
- 4. Classroom bulletin board display materials, and
- 5. A unit of study relating to Civil War medicine that supports our school's GPS Standards.

  Lessons will focus on reading comprehension, vocabulary, individual research projects, map reading exercises, drama, and science. Primary source use will be emphasized in readings.
